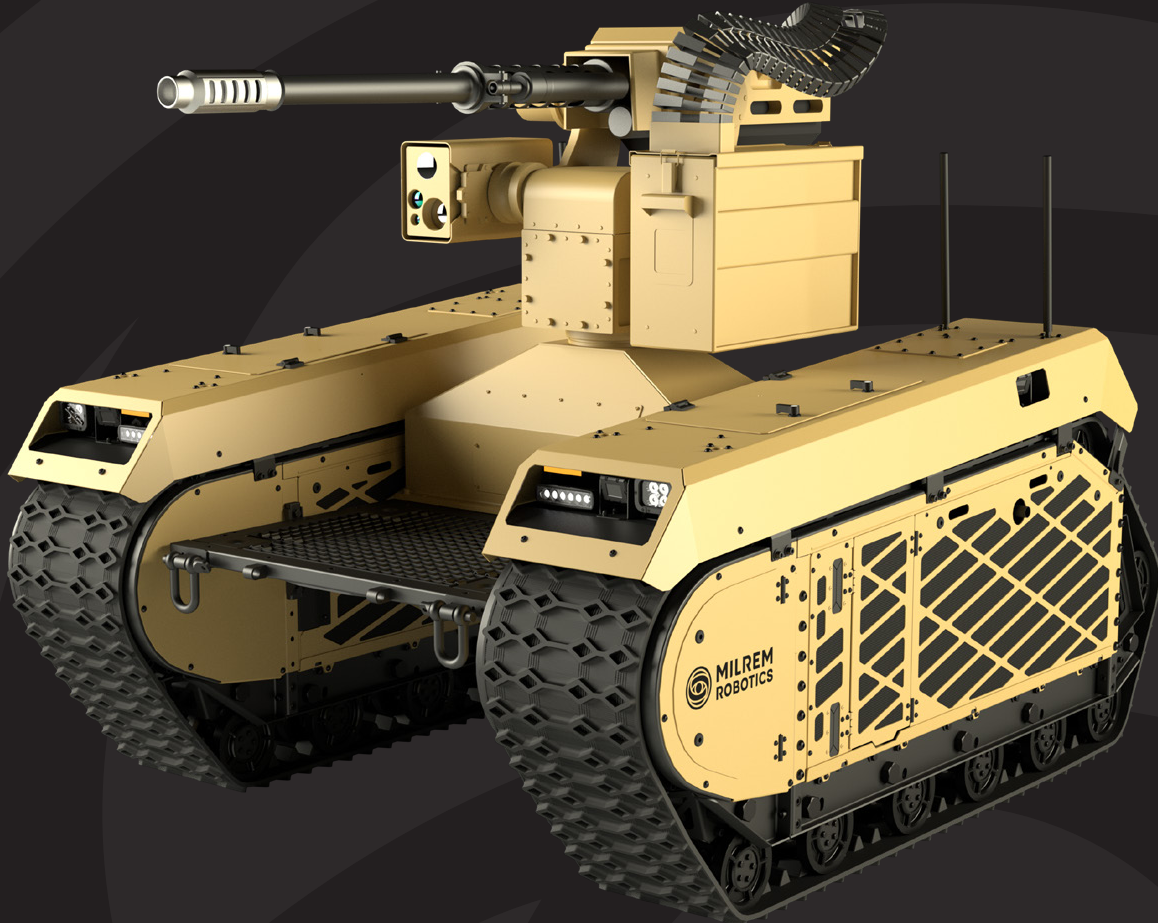


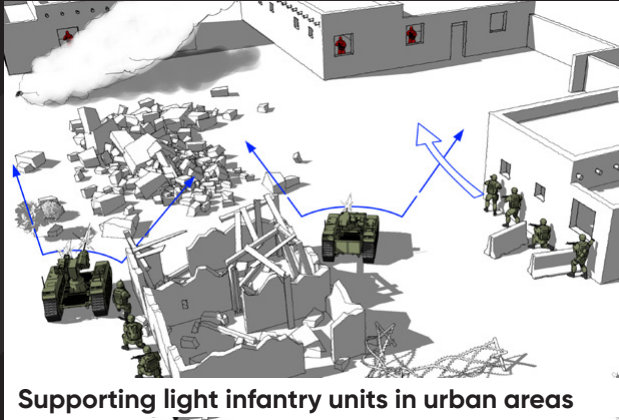
THeMIS COMBAT + R400S-MK2-D-HD



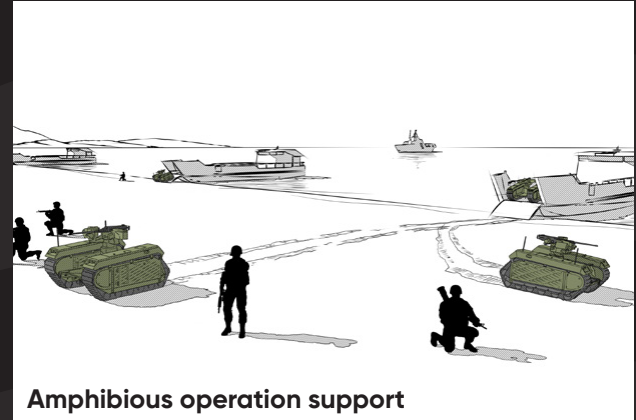

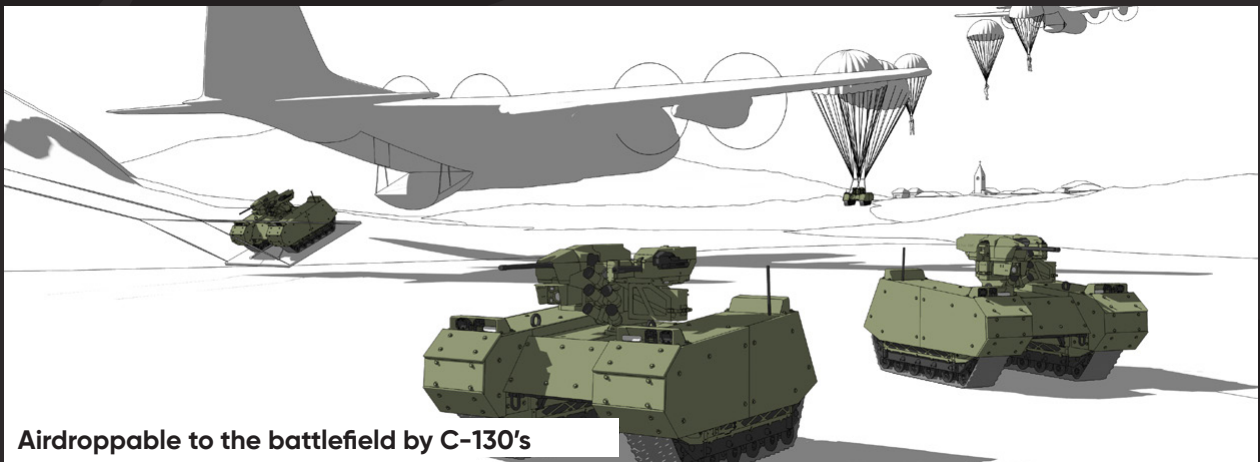
